3. After your application is reviewed and all information is verified, and if your application is approved, you will receive an Eligibility Approval Form from OCTA which includes instructions on how to obtain your photograph and identification card.
4. There is a \$4.00 fee which must be paid at the time your photo is taken.

Should an application for the Senior Citizen Identification Card be denied, the applicant must submit a written appeal within 14 days of denial letter date, requesting a review and reconsideration of the application.
