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The Orange County Transportation Authority reserves the right to make final determination of eligibility for Senior Citizen Identification Cards. The applications are for internal use only and will not be subject to public review. It is understood that the issuance of the Senior Citizen Identification Card is for the purpose of identification on the fixed route bus system and is not transferrable. Should an application for the Senior Citizen Identification Card be denied, the applicant must submit a written appeal within 14 days of denial letter date, requesting a review and reconsideration of the application.



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Instructions for completing and submitting this application:

1. Complete the above information in its entirety.
2. There is a non-refundable \$4 application fee which must be paid at the time your application is sent. Please make check payable to OCTA.
3. Attach a 2x2 color photograph in the photo application section below.
4. Complete the Application Checklist to ensure all of your application materials are ready for processing. When your application is complete, mail your application to us at:

5. After your application is reviewed and all information is verified, and if your application is approved, you will receive your Reduced Fare Identification Card by mail within 2-3 weeks from the receipt of your application.
6. If your application is denied you will receive a letter stating the reason for denial. Your \$4 application fee is non-refundable and will not be returned.

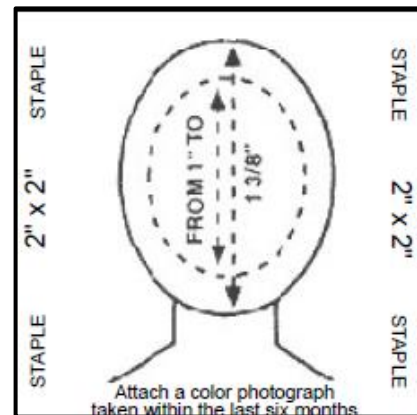
Photo Application Section (Required)

- I. A recent photograph is required to complete your application. Please review the guidelines below and attach your photo in the box provided.

II. Photo Specifications

- Full face photo only
- Photo size 2x2 inches
- No hats or sunglasses
- Please use a plain light (white or off-white) background
- Photo must fit in space provided (cut to size)
- Photo must be on photo quality paper, not on photocopy paper
- A snapshot, vending machine prints, and magazine or full-length photographs are unacceptable.

- III. Applications with photos that do not adhere to these guidelines will NOT be processed.

- Completed Photo Application section with 2x2 inch color photograph that follows the guidelines

- Photocopy of the selected form of identification used if applicable
