### ADDICTION SERVICES OVERVIEW

Hurtt Family Health Clinic offers addiction medicine and chemical dependency services to treat patients with many types of substance use including opioids, stimulants, sedative hypnotics, kratom, cannabis, inhalants, nicotine, hallucinogens and others.

We also see patients without an addiction for a chemical dependency consultation. This includes patients who want to taper off substances such as cannabis, opioids or benzodiazepines.

Additionally, referrals for behavioral addictions such as masturbation/pornography/sex, love, shopping, internet/social media, gambling, work and videogames will be considered.

Hurtt Family Health Clinic offers substance use disorder medications including but not limited to buprenorphine/suboxone, naltrexone and naloxone. We will soon have injectable sublocade and vivtrol available as well.

Our patients are supported by a compassionate and competent team that include physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses, therapists and care coordinators.

#### BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES
